SUBJECT:

Second Amendment to Cleaning, Inspection, and Repair Services Agreement with Fire-Dex GW, LLC dba Gear Wash Las Vegas to Increase the Annual Not-to-Exceed Amount to \$130,000.00 from \$95,000 for the Initial Three-Year Term and Two One-Year Renewal Options. RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:

Approve the Second Amendment to Cleaning, Inspection, and Repair Services Agreement with Fire-Dex GW, LLC dba Gear Wash Las Vegas.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$650,000.00

Explanation: The value of the agreement is \$130,000.00 each fiscal year for a total not to exceed value of \$390,000.00 for the initial three-year term, or \$650,000 if both one-year extensions are exercised.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On September 11, 2023, the City and Fire-Dex GW, LLC doing business as Gear Wash Las Vegas (“Gear Wash”) entered into the Cleaning, Inspection, and Repair Services Agreement for cleaning; repairing and maintenance services that meet OSHA and NFPA regulations, standards, and recommendations for the Fire Department's uniforms and gear. The Fire Department uses this service to clean, repair, inspect and recertify turnout gear after contamination from fire or other emergency incidents. On March 13, the City and Gear Wash entered into a First Amendment to amend the compensation section of the Original Agreement to increase the annual not-to-exceed amount from \$85,000 to \$95,000.

The Fire Department seeks to enter into the Second Amendment to the Agreement to increase the annual not-to-exceed amount from \$95,000 to \$130,000, for a total amount of \$650,000, including both one-year option renewals. The Fire Department is making this request because of the need for additional gear cleaning services due to an increase in Fire Department personnel resulting from the opening of Fire Station 58, and an increased volume in live fire training and structure fires. The Fire Department has budgeted for this in 00100-300232-430631.
