STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On November 2, 2022, City Council awarded a construction contract to American Southwest Electric for \$2,016,618.85 for the Kiel Ranch Historic Park – Phase IV Project (Project). The Project consisted of improvements to the Kiel Ranch Historic Park. The project work included demolition, earthwork, grading, a plaza overlook, shade structures, trails, parking lot, a rapid flashing beacon, interpretive signs, onsite utilities, landscaping, an irrigation system, signage, LED lighting, and all other associated site work and appurtenances necessary to complete a functional project.

The Project was completed on time and under budget with a final contract amount of \$1,997,594.17. The work is completed and ready for final acceptance. Upon final acceptance of the Project, the Notice of Completion will be signed by the Mayor and recorded at the Office of the County Recorder.

As per the Contract, the Contractor is required to guarantee the work for one year, effective March 15, 2024.
