**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Clark County proposes the levy of a surcharge on telecommunications and telephone service for the enhancement of the telephone system used for reporting emergency and purchase and maintenance of event recording devices. Clark County commissioned a 5-year Master Plan that provides a framework for the creation of an Advisory Committee that will provide fair and balanced representation for the defined public safety answering points (PSAPs) within Clark County, and the jurisdictions that support and oversee the same. The City, along with all other jurisdictions that have PSAPs, has been requested to have their governing bodies publicly indicate support of the 911 surcharge 5-year master plan.
