STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The support for the jail management software (JMS) used for the City of North Las Vegas' Community Correctional Center will end in July 2025. The JMS primarily handles the intake, management and discharge of inmates. The current software (OffenderTrak) was first installed in 2004 and hasn't had a software update in more than 10 years. As a result, Corrections staff is not able to take advantage of the improvements in current software functionality including inmate identification/classification, resource and location management, reporting and analytics, mobile device access and a variety of industry technology architecture and software advancements.

In the last year the Corrections team had the opportunity to meet with a number of JMS vendors to evaluate software capabilities, industry standards and improvements. Based on these initial evaluations and comprehensive follow up demo sessions the team has selected Beacon Software Solutions as the next JMS provider for the City of North Las Vegas. Some of the features that separated Beacon Software Solutions from its competitors include:

- Variety of inmate identification, classification methods
- Robust incident tracking
- Configurable reporting, dashboards and analytics
- Form generation
- Industry partnerships and connectivity
- Mobile solution
- Ability to integrate with the city's existing and future court system

Beacon is the licensor of its software suite as well as the implementer for installation, configuration, set up and training. The Community Correctional Center will benefit with efficiency gains and functionality of a modern JMS as well as the flexibility to integrate with federal, state and customized integration partners.
