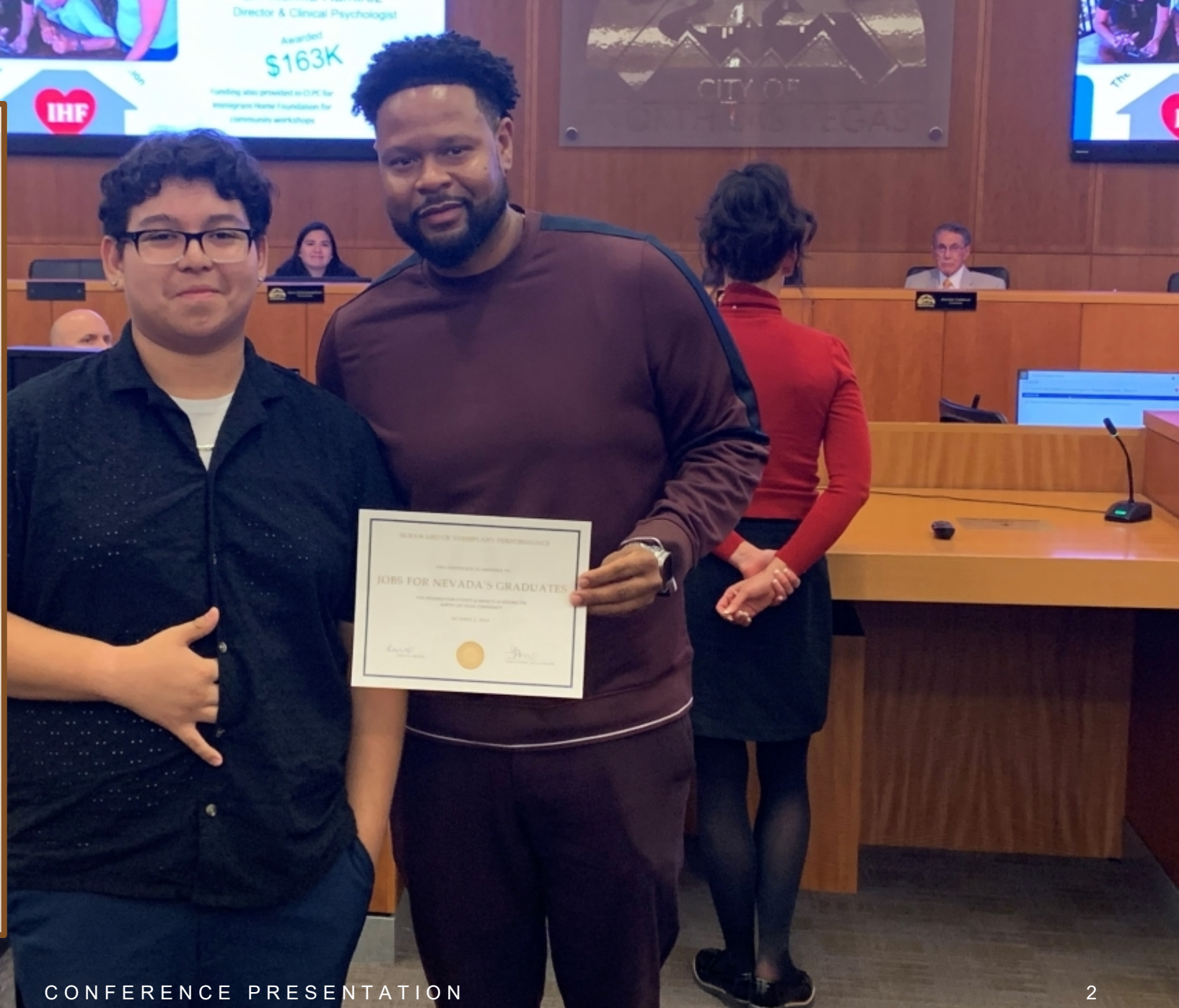
What We Are: A Multi-Year Work-Readiness & Career Preparation Program Embedded in High Schools

\$40,000 Requested from CDBG for highly effective JAG Program At Canyon Springs HS

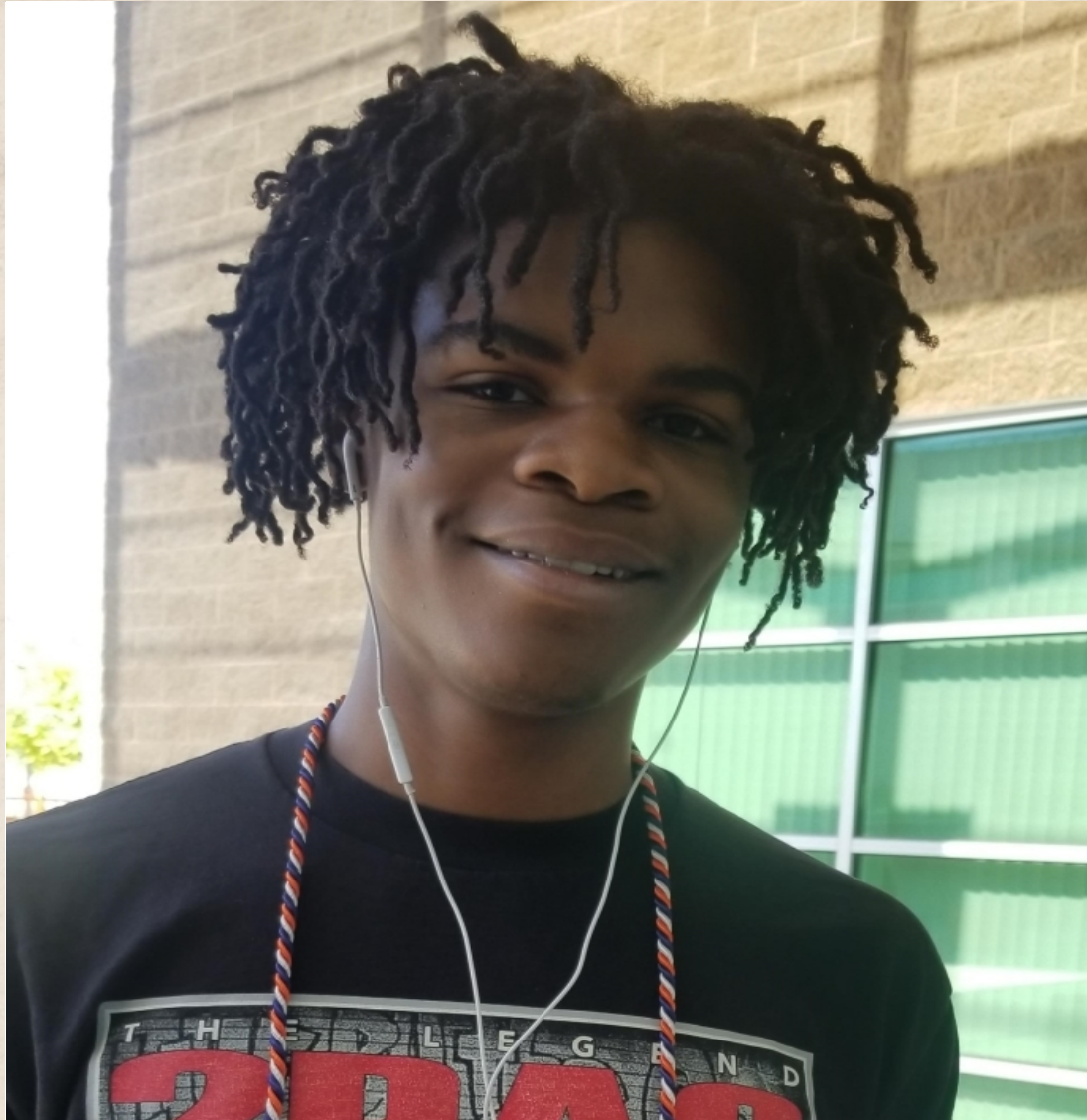
\$75,000 Match from other funding sources provided by JAG Nevada
