STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City of North Las Vegas (City) and CenturyLink Communications, LLC dba Lumen (Lumen) entered into the Information Technology Services Agreement (Services Agreement) in December 2017 to replace and replace the City's 911 system. The Services Agreement was for a term of five years. In November 2021, the City and Lumen entered into an Amendment to the Services Agreement. The parties wish to extend the Services Agreement through April 30, 2025. Approval of the Services Agreement will provide the City's Police Department the ability to service our community by dispatching officers in response to 911 calls.
