STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds may be used for four program components: street outreach, homelessness prevention, rapid re-housing assistance, Homeless Client Data Collecting, as well as administrative activities (up to 7.5% of a recipient's allocation can be used for administrative activities)

The projected formula-based allocation is part statutory and part regulatory. The \$164,055 allocation is contingent upon US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) final approval. The ESG program provides funding to engage unsheltered homeless individuals and persons at risk of homelessness.

The North Las Vegas Citizens' Advisory Committee (CAC) met during the year as noted to provide the following recommendations. September 5, 2023: The North Las Vegas Citizens' Advisory Committee (CAC) began the second year review of the grant cycle. October 3, 2023: Review Resolution 2714; Set the dates and times of meetings; Discuss 5-Year Consolidated Plan; Discuss FY 2023/24 Annual Action Plan. November 7, 2023: Presentation of Open Meeting Law; Bus Tour discussion. February 8, 2024: Review of current Subrecipient spending and service numbers were reviewed. Prioritizing of funding allocation recommendations for CDBG funding of FY 2024-2025 were voted on and approved. The recommendations are listed in Exhibit A.
