**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The projected FY 2025-2026 Community Block Grant (CDBG) formula-based allocation is intended to be used to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing, a suitable living environment, and the expansion of economic opportunities, principally for low and moderate income persons. The projected formula-based allocation is part statutory and part regulatory. The \$294,400 projected allocation is contingent upon the US Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) approval.

The North Las Vegas Citizens' Advisory Committee (CAC) has been actively engaged throughout the grant process for the year. Below is a detailed timeline of the key milestones and actions taken by the CAC to ensure a transparent and thorough process:

- September 3, 2024: The CAC initiated the grant application process.
- October 4, 2024: Zoomgrants applications officially opened, providing eligible applicants with the platform to submit their funding requests.
- November 8, 2024: The application period closed, marking the beginning of the CAC's review and scoring of the final submissions.
- December 3, 2024 & January 7, 2025: Public hearings were held, allowing eligible applicants to present their proposals and respond to questions from the CAC regarding their funding needs and project objectives.

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-January 21 & 23, 2025: A bus tour was organized to visit the proposed program locations. This provided committee members with an opportunity to observe the on-the-ground impact of each proposal.

-February 4, 2025: The CAC convened for the allocation meeting to prioritize and finalize their funding recommendations. After careful deliberation, the committee voted to approve the final list of recommendations for City Council consideration.

The CAC's recommendations are detailed in Exhibit A, which is attached for review.
