Citibot is an AI-powered chatbot platform that allows citizens to report issues, ask questions and receive information about City services through their preferred communication channel, whether by text message or email or via social media. Citibot also uses AI translation to support 71 languages, a key component to serving our diverse community.

## Las Vegas Blvd Improvement Project

Work is progressing on our Las Vegas Boulevard Improvement Project. Construction is anticipated to begin in Spring 2025.

The project includes

- Roadway rehabilitation
- Installation of a new regional flood control facility for Las Vegas Boulevard between Tonopah Avenue and Carey Avenue
- ADA upgrades
- Sidewalk, curb and gutter improvements
- Median island curbs
- Irrigation and landscaping
- Utility relocations
- Streetlight upgrades
- Pedestrian safety enhancements
- Traffic signal modifications
- Fiber optic cable installation

This project is part of our strategic plan to improve infrastructure for residents!
