The FY23 Homeland Security Grant Program award will enhance the existing Hostile Incidents Medic Program and expand its capabilities to support an “all hands” approach to the rescue component of a hostile mass casualty incident response. More specifically, this project will give the City of North Las Vegas’s the capability to respond to an incident resulting from an act of terrorism that would require the deployment of highly trained and equipped law enforcement and medical personnel for triage and treatment of survivors of an act of terrorism.
