STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This interlocal agreement is the product of the Homelessness Intervention proposal introduced by the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition to address the needs of homeless persons in the area. City Council has approved similar homeless-related interlocal agreements in each fiscal year since 2004. The agreement requires Clark County, City of Henderson, City of Las Vegas, and City of North Las Vegas to share funding based on a population formula to pay for emergency shelter services for Clark County's homeless persons. Since it was established several years ago, the multi-jurisdictional collaboration has been very successful and is being used nationally as an example of a best practice.

The interlocal agreement is for the fiscal year July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025, and specifies the funding requirements for the participating jurisdictions. The total joint regional commitment for emergency shelter remains the same for the previous fiscal year and it totals \$596,769. North Las Vegas's portion of that amount is \$65,643.49 (11% of the total). Each jurisdiction is currently in the process of approving the interlocal agreement with their respective governing bodies. Staff recommends approval of the interlocal agreement.
