**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

An invitation to Bid B-1739 was issued for citywide fencing services. Two vendors responded to the bid: Red Star Fencing and The Tiberti Fence Company. The Tiberti Fence Company was awarded the bid as the lowest and most responsive bidder. The fencing services will be used for citywide repair projects, flood channel and detention basin repairs, and emergency purposes. Any repairs completed at the flood channels and detention basins are reimbursable by the Clark County Regional Flood Control District.
