STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City conducted Bid Number B-1707 seeking services to remove five (5) Granular Activated Carbon units (GAC) and replacement of screens, if necessary. The Granular Activated Carbon (GAC) system is used for odor control at the Water Reclamation Facility (“WRF”) and is needed to comply with Clark County Air Quality permits. The two (2) companies that submitted bids are Carbon Activated Corporation and CarbUSA LLC. Carbon Activated Corporation was selected as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder to perform this service.

Staff recommends that the City Council Award Bid Number B-1707 and Approve the Services Agreement with Carbon Activated Corporation in an Amount Not to Exceed \$219,195, funded by the Utilities Enterprise Fund, for the granular activated carbon change out at the WRF.
