Fourth Amendment to Services Agreement with So. Nev. T.B.A. Supply Co. dba Ted Wiens Tire & Auto Center for Goodyear and Bridgestone/Firestone Tire Products to Increase the Total Not to Exceed Amount by \$89,100 (from \$847,225.10 to \$936,325.10) Utilizing NASPO Agreement Pricing. Agreement increase from \$847,225.10 to \$936,325.10. 4th Amendment increase in the amount \$89,100 towards extension year number 2.

EXPLANATION: This amount is approved in the annual Fleet Operations' Service and Supplies budget for Garage Auto expenditures.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Fourth Amendment to increase the total not-to-exceed amount is needed to cover forecasted increase in total expenses for FY 24-25 and beyond. The City's Fleet Operations Division purchases vehicle tires, as needed for vehicles throughout its entire fleet, as part of preventive maintenance and to increase vehicle safety. The City's agreement with Ted Wiens Auto Center allows Fleet Operations to receive government approved pricing through NASPO. Fleet Operations establishes a budget for supplies such as tires each fiscal year. The funding utilized in this agreement has already been set aside and spending patterns for multiple years support these costs.

The Department is utilizing NRS 332.195(1)(a), which permits the City to enter into a contract pursuant to a solicitation by a governmental entity located within or outside this State with the authorization of the contracting vendor, and which allows the City to forego the standard competitive bidding procedure.
