**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

On November 3, 2021, City Council approved the Multi-jurisdictional Interlocal contract for the Trail Maintenance Volunteer Coordination Fiscal Year 2022-2024 (“Project”), which provides funding for the Regional transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) to administer the Project.

This interlocal contract allows RTC to contract with a service provider to coordinate the work of volunteers in performance of trail maintenance activities within jurisdictions’ right-of-way for City of North Las Vegas, City of Las Vegas, Boulder City, City of Mesquite, City of Henderson, and Clark County. The RTC facilitates and funds this Project for all the entities.

On May 3, 2023, City Council approved Supplemental Interlocal Contract No. 1 that increased RTC funding for the Project in the amount of \$200,000 for Fiscal Year 2023.

The RTC approved Supplemental Interlocal Contract No. 2 on September 14, 2023 that allocated an additional \$150,000 for the Project for Fiscal Year 2024.
