STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City proposes to use the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development grant funds for three projects. At Cheyenne Sport Complex, \$6,760,000 (Award B-24-CP-NV-1519) will be used for the Cheyenne Park Safety and Activity Project to add critical safety elements, activity centers, and a park maintenance hub to provide a variety of health benefits to low and moderate income residents. For the Dolores Huerta Resource Center, \$1,616,279 (Award B-24-CP-NV-1517) will be used to fund a one-stop shop to provide services to the community which include legal services, education, workforce development training, arts and culture, physical and mental health support, and technology training. For the Fire Department, \$1,000,000 (Award B-24-CP-NV-1518) will be used for the Fire Training Facility project to fund the purchase of a modular structure to house a classroom and offices to train firefighters.
