STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) staff recommends approval for the Agreement to Use Local Government Contract for Wastewater Treatment Chemicals (Agreement) with Pioneer Americas LLC (Vendor). The Agreement is a joinder agreement to an existing agreement between Vendor and Clark County Water Reclamation District (CCWRD) pursuant to NRS 332.195. Vendor is the current supplier for the WRF. The agreement with CCWRD provides this necessary chemicals at a reasonable and competitive cost. Sodium Hypochlorite is used at the WRF to control organic fouling on membrane cassette fibers and it is also added to the treated water effluent as a disinfectant to protect the receiving waters. This final addition to the treated water is required by the WRF's NDEP Discharge Permit. The initial term of the agreement will run from September 1, 2024 through June 30, 2027. The City has two optional renewal terms; the first renewal option runs from July 1, 2027 through June 30, 2028 and the second renewal option runs from July 1, 2028 to August 31, 2029.
