Amount: \$82,797.75

Explanation: Provides \$82,797.75 in new grant funds for FY 2024-2025. A 20% local in-kind match is required.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Police Department currently provides victim advocacy services to the North Las Vegas community. The advocates provide a wide range of services to victims of crime including providing information on victim rights, referral to other support agencies, general counseling, assistance with filing protective orders, and other requirements encountered during the judicial process. The grant award will provide \$82,797.75 for FY 2024-2025 for the victim advocacy services, and requires a twenty percent (20%) local match.
