**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Apex Elevated Water Tank Project is near the intersection of Apex Power Parkway and US-93 in Northern Apex and will provide reliable water infrastructure to existing and future facilities at Apex Industrial Park.

On April 9, 2024 the City Manager approved the On-Call Professional Coating Inspection Services Agreement with the Industrial Inspection Group, Inc.

Coating Inspection Services were and are required for the Apex Elevated Storage Reservoir Project. Amendment No. 1 will fund the additional coating inspections required for this project in an amount not-to-exceed \$99,000.
