STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City previously entered into a Manhole & Valve Cover Agreement with the Nevada Department of Transportation (“NDOT”) regarding Project SPI-015-1(088), a road rehabilitation project conducted by NDOT on Lamb Blvd (Route SR-610). NDOT’s work on the Project recently revealed significant erosion of the manholes within the Project area, attributed to elevated levels of hydrogen sulfide (H₂S). Consequently, it was deemed essential to perform emergency repairs and apply a protective coating to the existing manholes in order to enhance the structural integrity of the infrastructure and prolong its operational lifespan. Furthermore, the manhole and valve cans were raised to meet the increased road elevation requirements for compliance with applicable codes.

Pursuant to the Agreement, the Utilities Department agreed to reimburse NDOT for the costs to have their contractors carry out the work on a time and materials basis, as the road was already closed and access to the work site was restricted. Due to the timing, the Utilities Department was unable to seek Council approval prior to obtaining the services. Staff recommends that Council ratify the purchase order for the emergency work provided by NDOT.
