STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. ("ESRI") develops, maintains, and sells technology products which are a core component of the City's mapping program, including its Geographic Information Systems ("GIS") software. GIS is used to create maps, produce map applications, perform spatial analysis, integrate map data to enterprise applications, and interface map data with peer government agencies. Map data served by ESRI technology includes but is not limited to parcels, zones, and Utilities Department assets, and Police Department crime data.

The Second Amendment renews the City's existing GIS licenses and support services and also provides for additional GIS software licenses and associated technical support, and includes annual licensing, maintenance, and technical support of ESRI software and subscriptions. It allows for use, upgrades, and technology support of software required for the City to stay current and secured with GIS tools.

This Second Amendment is exempt from the competitive bidding requirements under NRS 332.115(h) & (i).
