STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On September 7, 2022, the City approved Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Engineering Services Agreement for the Well Rehabilitation/Improvement Project with HDR Engineering, Inc. (HDR) to provide construction management support for the Well Rehabilitation/Improvement project in the not to exceed amount of \$1,736,080.

This Second Amendment to the Professional Engineering Services Agreement with HDR increases the total cost by \$79,578 from \$1,736,080 to \$1,815,658. This increase is due to procurement challenges and delays which required extensive reviews of substitute materials and equipment which extended the projects delivery date from 360 days to 660 days. City staff recommends that the City Council approve the Second Amendment.
