STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This Supplemental Interlocal Contract No. 5 (1164) has recently been approved by the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC).

The cities of North Las Vegas, Las Vegas, Henderson, Boulder City, and Mesquite, Clark County and the RTC partnered for the engineering of Maryland Parkway Bus Rapid Transit: Russell Road to Medical District Project. The RTC serves as both the financial and physical lead for this project.

On April 1, 2020 City Council approved a multi-jurisdictional Interlocal Contract for the Maryland Parkway Bus Rapid Transit: Russell Road to Fremont Street Project. Specifically, these improvements may include curb and gutter, asphalt pavement, sidewalk, median islands, intersection improvements, pedestrian and bicycle safety upgrades, and any other appurtenant items necessary for a complete project.

On May 19, 2021 Council approved Supplemental Interlocal Contract No. 1 which revised the project scope, and increased the design funds.

On January 4, 2022 Council approved Supplemental Interlocal Contract No. 2 which increased funds to acquire right of way along Maryland Parkway necessary to complete this project.

On January 17, 2024 Council approved Supplemental Interlocal Contract No. 3 which changed the project funding from RTC Fuel Revenue Indexing Extension funds to RTC Fund 05, Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax funds.

On February 21, 2024 Council approved Supplemental Interlocal Contract No. 4 which increased project funds due to the rise of engineering costs.

Supplemental Interlocal Contract No. 5 will increase funding to begin construction.

This project is administered and funded by the RTC.
