**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The City of North Las Vegas requires maintenance repair and operations (MRO) supplies, parts, equipment, and materials to support all City departments. The City will be joining the OMNIA contract between the City of Tucson and W. W. Grainger, Inc, Contract No. 240078-01, for the purpose of purchasing these supplies, parts, equipment, materials, and related services. NRS 332.195(1)(c) permits the City to enter into a contract pursuant to a solicitation by a cooperative purchasing organization with the authorization of the contracting vendor.

The initial term of this Agreement will be three years (FY 24/25; FY 25/26 & FY 26/27) and continue in effect until December 31, 2027. The total not to exceed amount per fiscal year is seventy-nine thousand dollars and 00/100 (\$79,000.00). Pursuant to the Agreement, the City Manager may extend the initial term for up to two additional one-year periods. The total not to exceed amount for this Agreement is three hundred ninety-five thousand dollars and 00/100 (\$395,000.00) if both renewal options are exercised.
