**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Central Reservoirs Rehabilitation Project consisted of cleaning and repainting the interior and exterior surfaces of three reservoirs as well as the installation and refurbishment of other tank appurtenances.

On March 3, 2021, City Council awarded the construction contract to Olympus and Associates, Inc. in the amount of \$6,623,684.34 for the Central Reservoirs Rehabilitation Project.

The final project cost was under budget at \$6,168,518.42. The work has now been completed and is ready for final acceptance. Upon final acceptance of the Project, the Notice of Completion will be signed by the Mayor and recorded at the Office of the County Recorder.

The Contractor is required to guarantee the work for one year and the cathodic protection for two years, effective from June 7, 2022.
