**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

This Interlocal Contract (Contract No. 3124) has been approved by the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) and City of Las Vegas.

The Lake Mead Boulevard Simmons Street to Losee Road Project includes pavement and sewer rehabilitation, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramps, sidewalk widening, pedestrian safety improvements, bicycle lanes, traffic signal upgrades, streetlight modernization, landscape enhancements, and any other miscellaneous items necessary to complete a functional project.

The construction fund total for interlocal contract No. 3124 is \$47,400,000. The City of Las Vegas, as the lead agency for the construction, will receive \$29,000,000. The City of North Las Vegas will receive \$18,400,000 for construction related costs.

This project is funded by the RTC.
