Business Impact Statement Regarding Ordinance No. 3208, Which Amends Title 5 of the North Las Vegas Municipal Code Relating to Business Licenses Generally to Include Provisions for Sidewalk Vendors and Providing for Other Matters Properly Relating Thereto. RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:

It is recommended that the City Council consider and approve the Business Impact Statement regarding the proposed amendment to the North Las Vegas Municipal Code Title 5 to include provisions for sidewalk vendors.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The intent of the proposed ordinance is to add a new business license category for sidewalk vendors and regulations pertaining thereto.

The cost of a business license for sidewalk vendors shall be \$150.00 annually. The regulations include that sidewalk vendors must have a State business license and a license through the Southern Nevada Health District. Additionally, there are restrictions on location, time, and manner of sidewalk vending included in the ordinance.

The proposed ordinance was published on the City's website, and on May 28, 2024, a Business Impact Notification was sent to all current business licensees as well as all chambers of commerce and trade associations as prescribed by NRS 237.030-237.110. The deadline to respond was June 18, 2024. The City only received one letter in response; it was from the Vegas Chamber. The Vegas Chamber voiced support for our ordinance as it aligns with legislative intent of SB92.

The City held a workshop to discuss the new ordinance and the procedures for obtaining a sidewalk vendor business license on Thursday, June 13th at 5 p.m. The meeting was open to the public, and questions were answered by City staff and a representative from the Southern Nevada Health District who also provided information on obtaining a health permit.
