6. Discussion Regarding Seastrand Park Centerpiece Designs. (For Discussion Only)

Park Project Manager Erin Reisweg displayed five illustrative design concepts of potential art installations provided by a consultant for Seastrand Park roundabout. She discussed each of the presented concepts for the Board to review and later decide upon. *(A copy of the presentation is available in the Clerk's Office for review, and the video presentation is available on the city's website at*

There was a consensus of the Board for **Ms. Reisweg** to present the concept at the next meeting so that all of the Board Members can see the design concepts before a decision is provided.

7. Discussion Regarding Traffic Circle Designs at Carey Avenue and Hamilton Street. (For Discussion Only)

Ms. Reisweg stated that she reached out to Traffic Engineering and spoke with **City Traffic Engineer, Timothy Riesman**, to see if they were working on any designs or had a project moving forward to address the roundabout or traffic circle at Carey Avenue. She stated that **Mr. Riesman** said that they are in the beginning and know that this is something that they are going to be working on. A definitive data has not yet been identified to start the design, but they have it down as a project that they will be working on very soon.

She continued stating the one thing that **Mr. Riesman** did mention the possibly adding sculptures or landscaping. As of now, they will not install a sculpture into that traffic circle due to the speed of the traffic. If there is an art piece, it might not last very long and would have to be replaced. She asked whether to keep this item on the agenda for future discussions. The Board provided a consensus to table the item.

8. Discussion on the Impact NV Tree Planting Project and the Current Goal. (For Discussion Only)

Park Superintendent Chris Vasquez stated the department will plant 100 trees by the end of November. Most of those trees (80 to 85) will be planted in Aviary Park. The remaining 15 trees will be planted at Deer Springs Park. The current goal for Impact Nevada in the next three years (3) is to plant 1,000 trees valley wide. Our goal here in North Las Vegas this fall will be 100, which they are already in the planning. Next year nearing Earth Day, we hope to have the last trees installed. Later, the city will plant another 100.

BOARD ITEMS

Member Maxwell reported on the overgrown brush on the trailhead at Centennial, as well as Tropical Park, as it may create safety issues for the public using the trails.

Member Brown commented on the child that was killed last week as he was being dropped off for school at Somerset Academy Loci campus. His comment today is really about parks, and the safety of our parks. He understand city staff has been in communication with the traffic engineer to see what more can be done to increase safety at our crosswalks. He encouraged city staff to look at this issue to determine how best to address the concerns.

Member McKenzie asked whether there is a way that we can get uniform application of safety measures at every crossing of the trail that crosses certain streets so to reduce safety concerns with crossing on the trailheads.
