Explanation: Funds are from the Roadway, Flood, and Utilities Departments' accounts. Materials will be used for the Flood Maintenance program. The City is reimbursed by the Clark County Regional Flood Control District.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

An Invitation to Bid Number B-1734 was issued for all types of aggregate, sand, and disposal of asphalt and concrete to be used by Public Works Roadway Division and the Utilities Dept. Two vendors responded to the bid: Apex Materials LLC. and Las Vegas Paving. Apex Materials LLC. was awarded the bid as the lowest and most responsive bidder. The annual not-to-exceed amount of this Agreement is \$55,000 (\$275,000 for five years if renewal options are exercised).
