STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Fire Station #51 project consists of the demolition and new construction of Fire Station 51 located at 2626 East Carey Avenue in North Las Vegas. The Carey Ave. Cathodic Protection System consists of the replacement of anodes on the City's 36-inch Carey Ave. waterline.

At the public bid opening held on September 12, 2024, eight bids were received, ranging from \$14,695,014 to \$15,925,865.92. Korte Construction Company provided the lowest, responsive bid pursuant to NRS 338.1389.

The construction for this project is to be completed in 450 consecutive calendar days from the issuance of the Notice to Proceed.
