3. School District Updates Presentation by Councilman Barron, North Las Vegas CCSD Non-Voting Trustee. (For Discussion Only)

Isaac Barron, Councilman and Appointed Trustee for the City of North Las Vegas for the Record Address, 2604 Stanley Avenue, North Las Vegas. He commented on the former Clark County Board Trustee who represented North Las Vegas who vacated her seat. The Board moved forward to appoint a person in District B to replace her and she is an educational professional; she will serve until January 2025.

Councilman Barron stated that one of the trustees is attempting to push forward a measure that has major policy effects on the Bond Oversight Committee. However, stating the Committee did not entertain the trustee suggestion. He expressed concerns related to transparency as it relates to meetings held. He stated that he had asked the Interim Superintendent a question regarding the declared fiscal emergency of \$50M, asking what happened with the money, as from week to week the amounts dwindled from \$50M to \$20M to \$12M to \$10M. He stated that he did not receive a response from the Interim Superintendent. He spoke of the discrepancies in the accounting by the board president, as he believes the school district does not know the amount of funding it actually has.

The public has a right to review the budget of the school district and that has not occurred. Despite everything that has happened here, North Las Vegas will not likely have fully licensed teacher in front of children. It is going to be the community that always has to pay the price. He provided an update on superintendent search, that it is delayed until February or March 2025.
