STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Las Vegas Boulevard Improvements (Tonopah Avenue to Carey Avenue) project (Project) consists of roadway and flood control improvements extending from Tonopah Avenue to Carey Avenue as shown on the vicinity map included with this agenda item.

On November 5, 2014, the City Council approved a Professional Engineering Services Agreement with C.A. Group, Inc. in the amount of \$600,000. On August 16, 2017, City Council approved Amendment No. 1 to include bid and CM support services, bringing the Agreement total to \$923,185. On May 5, 2022, City Council approved Amendment No. 2 to include utility conflicts resolution, bringing the Agreement total to \$1,323,185.

Public Works staff has negotiated Amendment No. 3 to the Professional Engineering Services Agreement for the Project to increase the not-to-exceed amount by \$500,000, which revises the contract total from \$1,323,185 to \$1,823,185. Amendment No. 3 funds additional design services to coordinate with developers in the downtown area and redesign the roadway.

This Project is funded by the RTC.
