STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This Interlocal Contract Boulder Highway Tulip Falls Drive to Wagonwheel Drive (Contract No. 3163) has recently been approved by the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC).

Clark County, the cities of Las Vegas, Henderson, North Las Vegas, Boulder City, Mesquite, and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada partnered for the Boulder Highway, Tulip Falls Drive to Wagonwheel Drive Project.

The Interlocal Contract for the Boulder Highway, Tulip Falls Drive to Wagonwheel Drive Project applies to the construction of a dedicated, center-running transit system, conversion of the existing six-lane roadway to a four-lane roadway, pavement rehabilitation, signing, striping, lighting of upgrades, landscaping, and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) enhancements for sidewalk, curb, and gutter improvements. In addition, this project will increase safety along the corridor by reconfiguring lanes to incorporate Complete Streets elements such as rectangular rapid flashing beacons (RRFB) pedestrian crossings and curb extensions (bull-outs).

The total cost for the contract shall not exceed \$30,000,000. This project is funded by the RTC.
