**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Southern Nevada Area Communications Council (SNACC) was formed in 1995 by a Cooperative Agreement between Clark County and the Las Vegas Valley Water District. Since then, the Clark County Water Reclamation District, the cities of Henderson, Las Vegas, North Las Vegas and Boulder City, the Clark County School District, and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada have become members of SNACC. Specifically, the City of North Las Vegas joined in July 1997. SNACC provides a radio backbone system with transmitters and repeaters that deliver an 800 megahertz radio service that provides interoperable communications among numerous government agencies within Clark County.

All two-way radio users employed with the City of North Las Vegas utilize the SNACC radio system. SNACC will utilize these annual fees for the operating costs of maintaining the system.
