That the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute a contract with Medtec Ambulance Corporation in an amount not to exceed \$530,000.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The requested equipment will provide a replacement of rescue apparatus units 866 & 867, which were placed in service in 2001. Standards indicate useful front line service at seven years. This will give the City two new rescue apparatus for EMS and Fire responses. These apparatus will be more reliable, and as a result, will improve the quality of service and safety provided to the employees, citizens and businesses of the City. Units 866 & 867 will be rotated down into a second line reserve status. These apparatus were approved in the FY 2009-2013 CIP but due to the long lead time of 9 months, the purchase is being requested now.

Pursuant to NRS332.195, the City will utilize the terms of a contract between Medtec and the City of Las Vegas.
