

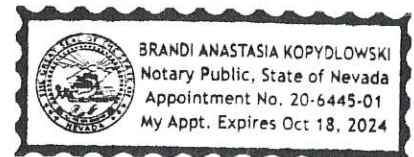

No Exception on Terms.

AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE GRAFFITI-ABETEMENT TRUCKS

This Agreement to Purchase Graffiti-Abetement Trucks (“Agreement”) is made and entered into as of _____ (“Effective Date”) by and between the City of North Las Vegas, a Nevada municipal corporation (“City”) and [name of entity], a [state of registration and type of entity] (“Provider”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase four (4) graffiti trucks as detailed on Invitation to Bid B-1674 (“Invitation to Bid”), attached hereto as Exhibit A (“Products”).

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase the Products from Provider as outlined in this Agreement, including Exhibit A and Exhibit B, and Provider agrees to sell and deliver the Products upon the terms and conditions described in this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the City and the Provider agree to the following terms, conditions, and covenants:

SECTION ONE RESPONSIBILITY OF PROVIDER

1.1. The Provider shall perform all of its obligations in the manner set forth in this Agreement including, without limitation, selling the Products to the City at the prices and quantities set forth in the Provider’s bid dated [] (“Bid”) attached hereto as Exhibit B, complying with the terms of the Invitation to Bid, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and all related additional or incidental tasks necessary to effectuate the intent of this Agreement.

1.2. The Products shall be new and must meet or exceed the technical specifications detailed in the Bid or as otherwise specified by the City.

1.3. The Provider shall ship the Products to a shipping address specified by the City (“Delivery Location”) F.O.B. Delivery Location as ordered by the City. Provider bears all risk of loss or damage to the Products until delivery of the Products to the City. Title to the Products passes to the City only after delivery and unloading of the Products at the Delivery Location is complete. Delivery of the Products is not complete until such Products have physically been received and accepted by the City.

1.4. The Provider shall furnish all user, instruction, or operator manuals for the Products as applicable.

1.5. The Provider shall furnish copies of all standard product warranties, extended warranties, and service and maintenance agreements for the Products from any manufacturer. To the extent possible, the Provider shall transfer or assign such warranties and agreements upon the request of the City.

1.6. The Provider shall promptly notify the City any time that the Provider fails to meet the requirements of this Agreement and shall, at its own expense, promptly take all actions to come back into compliance with this Agreement. If the Provider performs any additional task without obtaining the City's prior written approval, the Provider does so at its own risk and expense.

1.7. The Provider shall at its own expense comply at all times with all municipal, county, state and federal laws, regulations, rules, codes, ordinances, and other applicable legal requirements.

SECTION TWO PAYMENT AND TERM

2.1. The term of this Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and continue until the Products have been delivered and accepted by the City, unless earlier termination with accordance with the terms herein. Depending on the Products quantity that the City orders from the Provider the City may pay the Provider for the Products up to an amount not to exceed [] (\$)] annually.

2.2. The prices in the Bid will remain in effect for the first three (3) years of the Agreement. No additional compensation shall be paid, and no increase in the time of performance shall be awarded to the Provider without the prior written authorization of the City to proceed with such changes.

2.3. Payment to the Provider shall be made within thirty (30) calendar days after the City receives each invoice from the Provider, provided that such invoice is complete, correct, and undisputed by the City. Upon reconciliation of all errors, corrections, credits, and disputes, payment to the Provider will be paid in full within 30 calendar days. Invoices received without a valid purchase order number will be returned unpaid. The Provider shall submit the original invoice to:

SECTION THREE REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

3.1. Provider represents and warrants for the benefit of City, in addition to any other representations and warranties made in this Agreement, with the knowledge and expectation of City's reliance thereon, as follows:

3.1.1. Provider is a duly formed and validly existing [entity type] and is in good standing pursuant to the laws of the State of Nevada and has the full power, authority and legal right to execute, deliver and perform under this Agreement.

3.1.2. The Products are now and shall be at the time of delivery free from any security interest, lien, or other encumbrance.

3.1.3. Provider is financially solvent, able to pay its debts as they mature, and possessed of sufficient working capital to perform all of its obligations under this Agreement.

3.2. The representations and warranties made by Provider survive the termination or expiration of the Agreement.

SECTION FOUR INSURANCE

Provider shall obtain and maintain, at its expense, the following insurance coverage for all work related to the performance of this Purchase Agreement: commercial general liability insurance, automobile liability insurance, worker's compensation insurance, and employers' liability insurance. While a copy of the Provider's insurance certificate is not immediately required, the City reserves the right to request a copy of the Provider's insurance certificate at any time during the Term of the Agreement. It is the Provider's responsibility to produce the insurance certificate upon the City's request.

SECTION FIVE TERMINATION

The City may terminate this Agreement at any time with or without cause upon notice to the Provider, and the City shall have no liability to the Provider for such termination except that the City shall pay the Provider for the reasonable value of the Products provided by the Provider to City up through and including the date of termination, provided that the Provider, within thirty (30) days following the date of the City's termination notice, submits an invoice for such Products in a form reasonably acceptable to the City and such invoice is supplemented by such underlying source documentation as is reasonably requested by the City.

SECTION SIX INDEMNIFICATION

Notwithstanding any of the insurance requirements or limits of liability set forth herein, the Provider shall defend, protect, indemnify, and hold harmless the City, and its officers, agents, and employees, from any liabilities, claims, damages, losses, expenses, proceedings, suits, actions, decrees, judgments, reasonable attorneys' fees, and court costs which the City suffers, and/or its officers, agents or employees suffer, as a result of, or arising out of, the negligent or intentional acts or omissions of the Provider, its agents, and employees, or anyone employed by any of them, in fulfillment or performance of the terms, conditions or covenants of this Agreement including, without limitation, compliance with the terms of Exhibit A, and Exhibit B. This Section shall survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement until such time as the applicable statutes of limitation expire.

SECTION SEVEN NOTICES

7.1. All notices, demands, and other instruments required or permitted to be given pursuant to this Agreement shall be in writing and be deemed effective upon delivery in writing if served by personal delivery, by overnight courier service, by facsimile, or by overnight express mail, or upon posting if sent by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, and addressed as follows:

7.2. The address to which any notice, demand, or other writing may be delivered to any party as above provided may be changed by written notice given by such party as above provided.

SECTION EIGHT SAFETY

8.1. Obligation to Comply with Applicable Safety Rules and Standards. Contractor shall ensure that it is familiar with all applicable safety and health standards promulgated by state and federal governmental authorities including, but not limited to, all applicable requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970, including all applicable standards published in 29 C.F.R. parts 1910, and 1926 and applicable occupational safety and health standards promulgated under the state of Nevada. Contractor further recognizes that, while Contractor is performing any work on behalf the City, under the terms of this Agreement, Contractor agrees that it has the sole and exclusive responsibility to assure that its employees and the employees of its subcontractors comply at all times with all applicable safety and health standards as above-described and all applicable City safety and health rules.

8.2. Safety Equipment. Contractor will supply all of its employees and subcontractors with the appropriate Safety equipment required for performing functions at the City facilities.

SECTION NINE MISCELLANEOUS

9.1. Nevada and City Law. The laws of the State of Nevada and the North Las Vegas Municipal Code shall govern the validity, construction, performance, and effect of this Agreement, without regard to conflicts of law. The parties to this Agreement consent to the jurisdiction of any court of competent jurisdiction in Clark County, Nevada to adjudicate any dispute related top this Agreement or actions to enforce or interpret the terms of this Agreement.

9.2. Assignment. Any attempt to assign this Agreement by the Provider without the prior written consent of the City shall be void.

9.3. Non-Waiver. The failure to enforce or the delay in enforcement of any provision of this Agreement by a party shall in no way be construed to be a waiver of such provision or right unless such party expressly waives such provision or right in writing.

9.4. Partial Invalidity. If any term of this Agreement should be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, all provisions not held invalid, void or unenforceable, shall continue in full force and effect.

9.5. Controlling Agreement. To the extent any of the terms or provisions in the Bid conflict with this Agreement, the terms and provisions of this Agreement shall govern and control. Any additional, different or conflicting terms or provisions contained in Provider's Bid or any other written or oral communication from Provider shall not be binding in any way on the City whether or not such terms would materially alter this Agreement, and the City hereby objects thereto.

9.6. Attorneys' Fees. In the event any action is commenced by either party against the other in connection with this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to its costs and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees, as determined by the court, including without limitation, fees for the services of the City Attorney's Office. This Section 9.6 shall survive the completion of this Agreement until the applicable statutes of limitation expire.

9.7. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior representations, agreements, and understandings of the parties. No addition to or modification of this Agreement shall be binding unless executed in writing by the parties hereto.

9.8. Time of Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Agreement.

9.9. Shipping. The Products are to be packaged in a manner that assures they are protected against deterioration and contamination. All shipments are to meet applicable D.O.T. Regulations. Serial numbers noted on the packing slip must match the serial number of the actual goods shipped. Incorrect or questionable documentation of serial numbers may result in shipment rejection. Shipments rejected due to Provider error will be returned solely at Provider's cost.

9.10. Inspection. An authorized representative of the City will inspect the Products at time of delivery. If deficiencies are detected, the Products may be rejected and the Provider will be required to make necessary repairs, corrections, or replacements. Payment and/or commencement of a discount period will not be made until the corrective action is made, the Products are re-inspected, and accepted.

9.11. Further Assurances. The Provider shall execute and deliver all such documents and perform such acts as are reasonably requested by the City to complete its obligations under this Agreement.

9.12. Effect of Agreement Termination. In the event this Agreement is terminated, all rights and obligations of the parties hereunder shall cease, other than indemnity obligations, and matters that by their terms survive the termination hereof.

9.13. Fiscal Funding Out. The City reasonably believes that sufficient funds can be obtained to make all payments during the term of this Agreement. Pursuant to NRS Chapter 354, if the City does not allocate funds to continue the function performed by the Provider under this Agreement, this Agreement will be terminated when appropriated funds expire.

9.14. Public Record. Pursuant to NRS 239.010 and other applicable legal authority, each and every document provided to the City may be a "Public Record" open to inspection and copying by any person, except for those documents otherwise declared by law to be confidential. The City shall not be liable in any way to the Provider for the disclosure of any public record, including but not limited to documents provided to the City by the Provider. In the event the City is required to defend an action with regard to a public records request for documents submitted by the Provider, the Provider agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the City from all damages, costs, and expenses, including court costs and reasonable attorney's fees related to such public records request. This section 8.14 shall survive the expiration or early termination of the Agreement.

9.15. Electronic Signatures. For purposes of this Agreement, the use of facsimile, email or other electronic medium shall have the same force and effect as original signatures.

9.16. Federal Funding. Supplier certifies that neither it nor its principals are presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, in receipt of a notice of proposed debarment or voluntarily excluded from participation in this transaction by any federal department or agency. This certification is made pursuant to the regulations implementing Executive Order 12549, Debarment and Suspension, 28 C.F.R. pt. 67, § 67.510, as published as pt. VII of the May 26, 1988, Federal Register (pp. 19160-19211), and any relevant program specific regulations. This provision shall be required of every subcontractor receiving any payment in whole or in part from federal funds.

9.17. Boycott of Israel. Pursuant to NRS 332.065(4), Provider certifies that the Provider is not currently engaged in a boycott of Israel, and Provider agrees not to engage in a boycott of Israel during the Term.

Warranty Coverage:

Products manufactured by Cobalt Truck Equipment LLC (CTE) are warranted to be free from defects in material and workmanship, under proper use, application and maintenance in accordance with CTE's written recommendations, instructions and specifications as follows:

- **Labor on CTE workmanship Six (6) months:** from the date the unit is put into service, as indicated on the sales invoice.
- **IMT One (1) year: Dom I/II/III/IV, DSC, Sitestar, Compressor, and Crane: Original parts,** from the date the unit or part is put into service as indicated on the sales invoice. As per the manufacturer warranty. **Excluding refurbished parts** which have a 90 day warranty. Consumables are not covered i.e. wear pads, seals, oils, filters ETC... (Refer to Iowa Mold Tooling for detailed warranty policy)
- **PTO / Pumps One (1) year: To be free of defects in materials and workmanship at date of purchase:** Failures due to **Fretting** which appears as a "rusting and wearing" from lack of grease, pressure spikes, contamination, operator error and failure to provide proper maintenance documentation to CTE are **not** covered. Manufacturer Warranty covers part only, additional parts and labor are the responsibility of the purchaser. (Refer to PTO/Pump Manufacturer for detailed warranty policy)
- **Original Vanair compressor One (1) year:** From the date the unit is put into service as indicated on the sales invoice. All compressor components including the shaft seal are warranted for **One (1) year**. The hydraulic motor is warranted for **Two (2) years**. Original Vanair rotary screw air end assembly only is covered for **Three (3) years**. (Refer to Vanair Manufacturing for detailed warranty policy)
- **Air N Arc 300 All-In-One Power System:** From the date the unit is put into service as indicated on the sales invoice. When following the prescribed maintenance schedule, the rotary screw compressor unit warranted for **Five (5) years**, and all the major components warranted for **Three (3) years**. (Note: engines are warranted separately by the engine manufacturer.) Batteries are warranted for **One (1) year**. Consumable products such as filters, oils etc. and electrodes are not covered. (Refer to Vanair Manufacturing for detailed warranty policy)
- **Miller Enpak:** From the date the unit is put into service as indicated on the sales invoice is warranted for **Three (3) years**. (Refer to Miller Electrical Manufacturing for detailed warranty policy)
- **Duro Reel: One (1) Year:** Only parts of the reel itself are covered. Does **not** include hoses and fairleads. Does **not** include labor. (Refer to Duro Manufacturing for detailed warranty policy)
- **Reelcraft Reel Two (2) year:** Only parts of the reel itself are covered. Does **not** include hoses. Does **not** include labor. (Refer to Reelcraft for detailed warranty policy)
- **Paint coverage Five (5) year:** on structural components such as crane bases, masts, booms, truck body doors and body panels to be free from defects such as corrosion, blisters, unreasonable color or gloss loss, or delamination determined to result from paint failure. This warranty is effective from the date the unit is put into service as indicated on the sales invoice. Damage such as chips, scratches, and corrosion due to dirt build-up or paint peeling off from use of pressure washers and normal wear that occurs through usage of the product is not covered under this warranty. Rust bleed out from inaccessible structural features as a result of prolonged moisture exposure does not constitute a failure in paint coverage or adhesion and is not covered under this warranty.
- **Parts NOT of CTE manufacture are warranted only to the extent they are warranted by the original manufacturer.** CTE's obligation under this warranty is limited to, and the sole remedy for any such defect shall be the repair or replacement (at CTE's option) of unaltered parts returned to CTE, freight prepaid, and proven to have such defect, provided such defect occurs within the above stated warranty period, is reported to CTE within fourteen (14) days of its occurrence, and all claims and failing parts are returned to CTE within thirty (30) days after the repair is completed. CTE pays ground freight **one-way only**. **Premium freight will be at the customer's expense.**

- **IMPLIED WARRANTY EXCLUDED** – Only authorized CTE warranties are valid and applicable to CTE product. These warranties are in lieu of all other express or implied warranties or representations, including warranties of merchantability, or fitness for any particular purpose, or of any other obligations on the part of CTE. CTE may, in specific instances and by **written approval of an officer of the firm, in advance** of any bid or sales, modify or extend the terms of the Standard CTE warranty.
- **WARRANTY REGISTRATION, SERVICE AND CLAIMS** – Warranty claims must be submitted and shall be processed in accordance with CTE's established warranty claim procedures. Warranty service must be performed by CTE or an agent **authorized, in advance**, by CTE. At the time of requesting warranty service, the **purchaser** must present evidence of the date of the delivery of the product. The **purchaser** shall pay any premium for overtime labor requested by **purchaser**; any charge for making service calls and for transporting the equipment to the place where warranty work is performed, unless otherwise authorized in writing by CTE. **NOTE:** Our warranty requires that all defective parts be returned to CTE freight prepaid.
- **PARTS AND LABOR RATE** – Labor reimbursement for warranty claims will be paid at the standard hourly rate of \$75.00, as reported to CTE, multiplied by the number of work hours listed on the warranty service report. CTE reserves the right to modify the claims for warranty work hours which appear excessive. Part reimbursement for warranty claims will be one hundred percent (100%) of the selling price paid by the authorized repair facility. Labor is **not** included on service parts.
- **WARRANTY VOIDED** – All obligations of CTE under this warranty shall be terminated: (1) if service other than normal maintenance, or normal replacement of service items is performed, by someone other than an authorized CTE representative, (2) if product is modified or altered in ways not approved by CTE, (3) if warranty work is performed before or without written consent from CTE, (4) upon delivery of product to purchaser, the CTE warranty policy is not acknowledged with a signature in the presence of a CTE representative.
- **PURCHASER'S RESPONSIBILITY** – This warranty covers only defective material and workmanship. It does **not** cover depreciation or damage caused by normal wear, accident, improper protection in storage, improper use or neglect. The purchaser has the obligation of performing the care and documentation of maintenance duties discussed in manufacturer written recommendation, instruction and specification. Any damage, which results because of purchaser's failure to perform such duties, shall not be covered by this warranty. The cost of normal maintenance and normal replacement of consumable service items such as wear pads, oil, etc. shall be paid by the purchaser.
- **CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES** – The only remedies the purchaser has in connection with the breach of performance of any warranty on CTE products are those set forth herein. In **no** event will CTE be liable for business interruptions, loss of sales and/or profits, rental costs or substitute equipment fees, costs of delay for any other special, indirect, incidental or consequential loss, costs or damages.
- **REPRESENTATIONS EXCLUDED** – CTE products are subject to no expressed, implied or statutory warranty other than herein set forth. No agent or representative has any authority to alter the terms of this warranty in any way whatsoever or to make any representations or promises, express or implied, as to the quality or performance of CTE products other than those set forth in CTE Warranty Policy.
- **CHANGE IN DESIGN** – CTE reserves the right to make changes in design or improvements at any time. CTE retains the right and abstains from any obligation to install aforementioned changes to any of CTE products that are already in service and/or have been accepted by purchaser. **NOTE:** Changes to this section of CTE warranty policy dated March 1st 2016 include **all** CTE products with an earlier in service date of the current CTE warranty policy, and CTE will not be held liable or implies any design changes will be made, offered, installed or upgraded and furthermore release any liability to incur any costs and/or fees associated.
