STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Brooks Avenue Site Improvements Project consists of various site improvements, pavement rehabilitation, and other appurtenances as necessary to construct a complete and functional project.

A selection committee evaluated and ranked all Statements of Qualifications from submitting engineering firms and established the current Transportation Engineering qualifications list. Atkins North America, Inc. was selected from this qualifications list to provide professional design services for this project.

Public Works staff negotiated a design fee with Atkins North America, Inc. not to exceed \$921,604 for design of the Vehicle Maintenance Facility for the Brooks Avenue Site Improvements.
