STATE COMMENTS AND BACKCROUND INFORMATION.					

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In order to keep up with the City's population increase and aging sanitary sewer system it will be necessary to perform repairs and to upsize some of the existing sewer lines. To assist with the design of the repairs and the sewer line projects, the Utilities Department desires to obtain an On-Call Professional Engineering Services Agreement with Jacobs Engineering Group. Having an On-Call Professional Engineering Services Agreement will speed up the reaction time to emergency design repairs and sewer oversizing projects to minimize the operational impact to the public.

A selection committee evaluated and ranked all Statements of Qualifications from submitting engineering firms and established the current Sanitary Sewer Systems ranking. Jacobs Engineering Group was selected from this qualifications list to provide professional design services for the repairs and projects. Utilities staff negotiated a professional design services fee agreement not to exceed \$250,000 for all repairs and projects.
