**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

This Supplemental Interlocal Contract (1174) has recently been approved by the RTC.

On May 6, 2020 City Council approved the Interlocal Contract with RTC for the Downtown Complete Streets and Pedestrian Improvements Project. The project includes construction of complete street elements to downtown roadways. The work includes removal and/or replacement of various sections of poor visibility, incomplete and/or inadequate crosswalks. Upgrades include installation of Light Emitting Diodes (LED) lights, bike paths, safe-walkable routes and other items necessary for pedestrian safety.

Supplemental Interlocal Contract No. 1 will increase funds in the amount of \$1,500,000, increasing the contract from \$3,675,000 to \$5,175,000 in order to construct the project.

This project is funded by the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada Fuel Revenue Indexing Funds.
