STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:			

On March 2, 2022, Council approved the Water and Sewer Assistance Program Vendor Agreement with the State of Nevada Department of Health and Human Services which allows funding for the Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) to be available to North Las Vegas residents who meet the low income requirements.

The original agreement and program was set to expire on September 30, 2023. This amendment will extend the eligibility period to March 31, 2024. Staff recommends approval of this amendment.
