STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This grant will enable the Police Department to participate in statewide, multi-jurisdictional traffic enforcement events that are focused on reducing fatalities and serious injury crashes. Project activities will focus on enforcement of safety belt and child safety seat laws, speed enforcement laws, pedestrian safety, and reducing impaired driving through selective traffic enforcement programs, saturation patrols and checkpoints. Events are planned between October 2023 and September 2024.
