RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:

Staff Recommends that the City Council Ratify the First Amendment to Prisoner Transportation Services Agreement with Hoyt Investigative Group, LLC, dba Blue Line Transport, increasing the total annual not-to-exceed amount of this agreement from \$50,000 to \$100,000.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

An agreement for extradition services, to transport individuals with outstanding warrants for the North Las Vegas Police Department, is currently in place with Hoyt Investigative Group, LLC, dba Blue Line Transport (“Hoyt”), for an annual amount not to exceed \$50,000. Given the quantity of services provided under this agreement, the total annual not-to-exceed amount needs to be increased to \$100,000. The State of Nevada reimburses the City the cost of extradition services.

The City had to enlist Hoyt’s services, on an emergency basis, for a number of unexpected extraditions related to a gang homicide. This extradition services exceeded the current agreement not-to-exceed amount of \$50,000. Due to the emergent nature of the required extradition services, the Police Department was unable to seek City Council approval prior to obtaining the services.

Staff recommends that City Council ratify the First Amendment to Prisoner Transportation Services Agreement Increasing the Annual Not-To-Exceed Amount from \$50,000 to \$100,000.
