Amendment to Agreement with ARC Health and Wellness Centers, LLC for Employee Medical Services, Increasing Pricing and the Original Contract Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$306,920 to \$406,314. (Citywide) (For Possible Action; Recommendation – Approve)

RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:

Staff Recommends that the City Council approve the contract amendment for employee medical services increasing providers pricing and the total amount of the agreement to an amount not to exceed \$406,314.00 annually.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$406,314

Explanation: \$150,000 annually from the Fire Department General Fund, and \$256,314 annually from various Police Department Funds.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

ARC Health and Wellness Centers, LLC. ("ARC") and the County of Washoe entered into an agreement for employee medical services effective July 1, 2019. NRS 332.195(1)(a) permits a governing body to adopt contracts terms of other government entities with the authorization of the contracting vendor without requiring competitive bidding. Accordingly, the City entered into an agreement with ARC adopting the terms in ARC's agreement with the County of Washoe. The original agreement between the City and ARC was for an amount not to exceed \$306,920.00.

Due to unforeseen inflation rates, ARC has increased its pricing. Washoe County has accepted this price increase. Staff recommends that the City Council approve amendments to the City's agreement with ARC, approving the new pricing and increasing the not-to-exceed amount of the agreement from \$306,920.00 to \$406,314.00 annually.
