Purchase Agreement with Cobalt Truck Equipment DBA Idaho Specialties for Four (4) Graffiti Trucks Built to the City's Specifications as Outlined in Bid Number B-1674 for \$561,444. (Citywide) (For Possible Action; Recommendation – Approve)

RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:

That City Council approve the purchase of four (4) Graffiti Trucks built to the City's specifications as outlined in Bid Number B-1674. The 2023 Ford F-350, 4x2 DRW Gas Graffiti Trucks Purchase Agreement will be sold for \$561,444 (For Possible Action).

EXPLANATION: These funds will be used to purchase four (4) Graffiti Trucks built city specifications outlined in Bid Number B-1674.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City issued BID B-1674 and Cobalt Truck Equipment LLC. was the most responsive bidder.

The City desires to purchase four (4) 2023 Ford F-350, 4x2 DRW Gas Graffiti Trucks built to the City's specifications outlined in Bid Number B-1674. The Purchase Agreement for the Graffiti Trucks is for a total of \$561,444.

Specifically, this request is to purchase replacement vehicles for (2) 2008 Ford F-250 Super Trucks (Vehicle 1442, 1455) and (2) 2006-2007 Ford Ranger Super Trucks (Vehicle 1270, 1392) that have reached their life expectancy due to age, mileage, and high maintenance and repair costs. At Fleets discretion, the vehicles being replaced will be sent to auction, used as reserve vehicles, or used for parts—depending on the condition of the vehicles at the time of replacement. To reduce costs and vehicle downtime, Fleet recommends replacing these vehicles immediately to avoid adverse impacts to Fleet's budget and the operations of both Fleet and the Utilities Department.
