STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City Attorney's Office presently provides victim advocacy services to the North Las Vegas community. The City Attorney's victim advocacy program is currently supported by one full-time victim advocate. The bilingual advocate provides a wide range of services (in English and Spanish) to women victims of crime including providing information on victim's rights, referral to other support agencies, general counseling and assistance with documents, filings (protection orders) and other requirements encountered in the judicial process.

Under the grant, we will continue expansion of our efforts by providing victim services to under-served populations; collaborating with outside agencies to respond to victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking; and conduction education workshops for faith-based organizations.

The grant is for a six-month period, July 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023. Through this grant the City will continue its subaward with Safe House who will continue to provide a contracted bilingual victim advocate to assist the City Attorney's Office with victim advocacy services.
