**RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION:**

That City Council approve the approve the grant submission, approve acceptance of any resulting grant award in the amount of \$72,765.00 from the Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Child and Family Services, for the North Las Vegas Police Department Victim Advocacy Program for FY2023-2024, and that it authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute the grant application and enter into appropriate related agreements for approved projects and programs as required and to administratively approve any revised final funding allocations or contract amendments as needed.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$72,765.00

Explanation: Provides \$72,765.00 in new grant funds for FY 2023-2024. The annual salary is \$107,765.00; therefore, a budget adjustment of \$37,000 is required. A local in-kind match is not required.

**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Police Department currently provides victim advocacy services to the North Las Vegas community. The Advocates provide a wide range of services to victims of crime including providing information on victim rights, referral to other support agencies, general counseling, assistance with filing protective orders, and other requirements encountered during the judicial process. The Grant Award will provide \$72,765.00 for FY 2023-2024 for the victim advocacy services, and does not require a local match.
