STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:			

An increase in the total not-to-exceed amount of this agreement is needed based on total forecasted expenses for fiscal year 2022-2023 for fire apparatus parts and installation services. Hughes Fire Equipment Inc. is the exclusive dealer for the sale, service, parts, and warranty of custom and commercial fire apparatus manufactured by Pierce Manufacturing Inc.in Clark County Nevada.

Multiple City fire department trucks, pumpers, rescues and fire apparatuses use Pierce Manufacturing Inc. parts and the City has Pierce Manufactured Inc. equipment within its fleet. Each fiscal year, fleet operations establish a budget for services and supplies such as those provided by Hughes Fire Equipment Inc.. The funding for this amended agreement and has already been set aside.
